### EXTRACT FROM THE CONSTITUTION – SECTION 5 “MEMBERSHIP”

- 5.1 Any employer engaged in building, constructing, altering and/or repairing all types of boats and/or ships, general woodwork undertaken in conjunction with ship repairs on vessels of all descriptions in the Republic of South Africa and any employer engaged in any industry incidental to the abovementioned activities shall be eligible for membership.
- 5.2 Application for membership shall be made on the form prescribed by a General Meeting and shall be lodged with the Secretary of the Association.
- 5.3 All candidates for membership shall be proposed and seconded by members of the Association and shall be admitted by a majority vote at the General Meeting by a show of hands.
- 5.4 An applicant to whom admission to membership is refused shall be provided with the reasons for such refusal and shall be entitled to a refund of the membership fee *paid*.
- 5.5 They must be *bona fida* members of SEIFSA.
- 5.6 They must pay statutory rates.
- 5.7 They must have appropriate, or adequate, insurance, depending on the service they provide.
- 5.8 Applications for admission or readmission to membership together with the yearly membership fee shall be lodged in writing with the secretary of the organisation.
- 5.9 Every application for membership shall be considered by the executive committee within four weeks of receipt thereof by the secretary.
